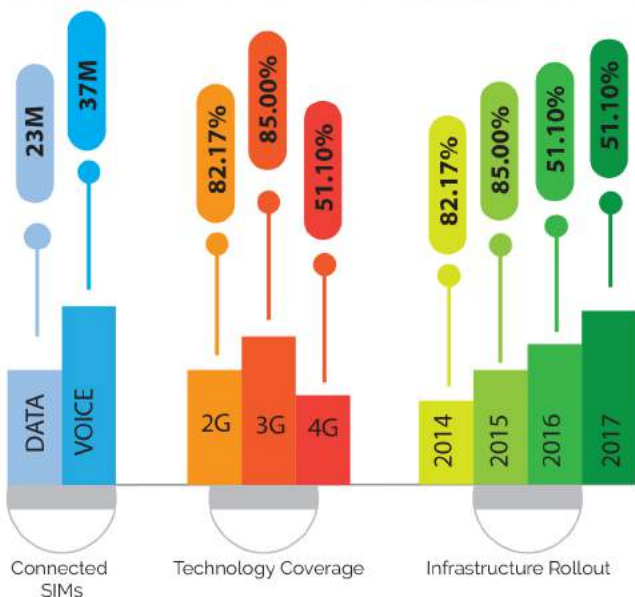




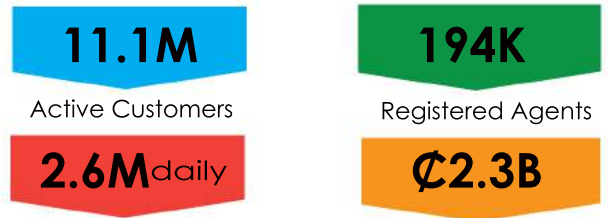

## Mobile Financial Services



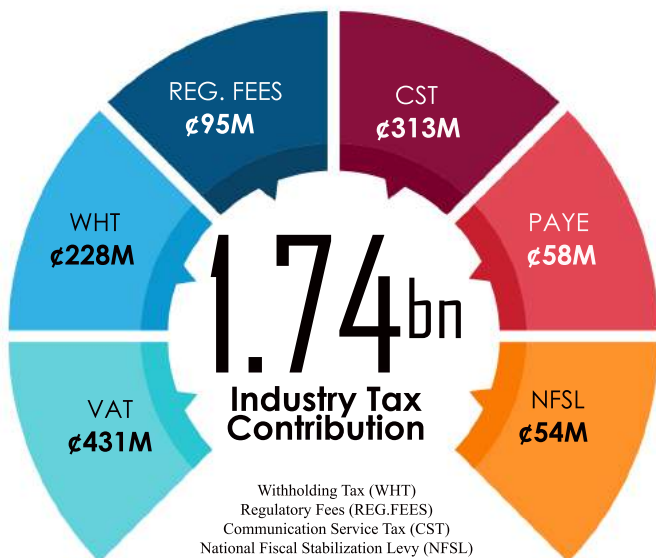
Mobile Money has supported Ghana's Drive for financial inclusion by extending the reach of financial services in the last decade than brick and mortar banking has in the last century
